

# Introducing the

# GLOVE AS A PHONE



Make beautiful music in 6 easy steps with just a rubber glove, a cardboard tube, a straw and some tape



**Step 1:** Poke or cut a small hole in the end of the pointer finger of the glove

**Step 2:** Push the straw through the hole from the inside of the glove, leaving about 2.5 cm (1") within the glove

**Step 3:** Tape the straw and glove junction, making an airtight seal. Use plenty of tape and check that the straw is firmly connected to the glove

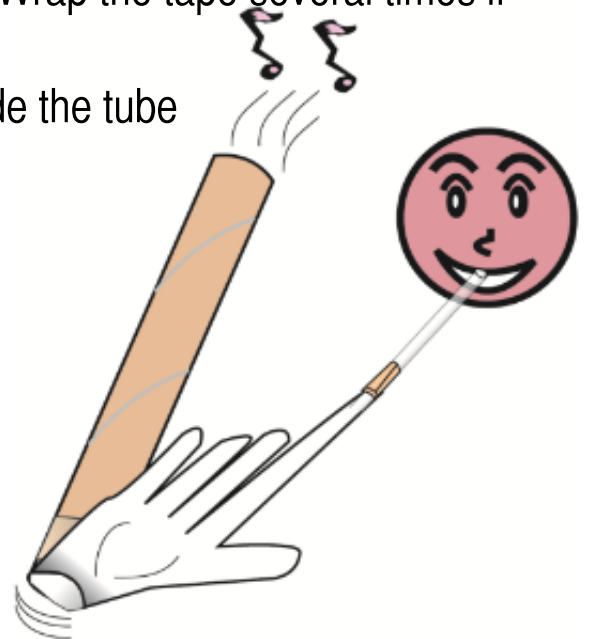
**Step 4:** Place the wrist of the glove over the tube and tuck the rest of the glove into the tube. This makes it easier to place the tape on the tube in the next step.

**Step 5:** Use the tape to secure the glove to the tube. Wrap the tape several times if needed

**Step 6:** Gently pull out the straw and glove from inside the tube



Hold the tube vertically and pull the glove so that the palm area covers the mouth of the tube - now blow into the straw! The part of the glove covering the tube forms a membrane which vibrates when you blow into the straw - it's these vibrations which create the sound.



Try altering the pitch of the sound by using different sized tubes, you can even try making holes in your tube to get different musical notes.
